Today in rehearsal we started our evening with a continued stumble through of our Act One followed by a stumble through of the giant set change choreography before moving onto a stumble through of our Act Two to conclude our night.

4. Kelsi Seiter (Stage Management) would like raise concern about the amount of weight both sets of stairs can hold as we noticed they creak and give when actors walk on them, more specifically those who weigh more.

5. Kelsi Seiter (Stage Management) would like to note that the pipes in the stage right wing are dripping water causing water damage to the rehearsal prop letters (Prop#21, 14, 6, 23). Stage Management has shifted stage right props in the meantime.


